Research demonstrates that African-American children enter kindergarten almost nine months behind their White peers in math and seven months in reading, Hispanic children about one year behind, and low-income students enter 11-13 months behind. This can be attributed to the opportunity gap, when one group of students has fewer opportunities to optimally learn and develop.
