Normative ethics is one of three main component areas of inquiry of philosophical ethics, the two others being meta-ethics and applied ethics. Normative ethics, also known as normative theory, or moral theory, intends to find out which actions are right and wrong, or which character traits are

good and bad. In contrast, meta-ethics, as the term suggests, is a study of the nature of ethics.

Recent ethical scandals in business (Colvin, 2003, Mehta, 2003, Revell, 2003) have raised important questions about the role of leadership in shaping ethical conduct.
