What are invading species? Invasive species are plants, animals, and micro-organisms introduced by human action outside their natural past or present distribution whose introduction or spread threatens the environment, the economy, or society, including human health (Government of Canada, 2004).

CITES is an international agreement between governments, aimed to ensure that international trade in specimens of wild animals and plants does not threaten their survival.

A chromosome is a package containing a chunk of a genome—that is, it contains some of an organism's genes. The important word here is "package": chromosomes help a cell to keep a large amount of genetic information neat, organized, and compact.
