Treating Borderline Patients

There are several treatments that are most often used to manage BPD. Dialectical behavior therapy (DBT) focuses on the concept of mindfulness, or paying attention to the present emotion. DBT teaches skills to control intense emotions, reduce self-destructive behavior, manage distress, and improve relationships.

Medications play three very important roles in the treatment of most patients with borderline disorder. 1) They are effective in reducing at least three of the four major symptoms of the disorder.. 2) They thereby enhance the rate and quality of improvement derived from psychotherapy.

Treatment Individuals with borderline personality disorder seek psychiatric help and hospitalization at a much higher rate than people with other personality disorders, probably due to their fear of abandonment and their need to seek idealized interpersonal relationships. These patients represent the highest percentage of diagnosed personality disorders (up to 60%).
